Dear ParkVista Residents, Families, and Resident Representatives,

As we reflect on the past 20 plus months since the start of the pandemic, I am thankful for your support of the constant changes, understanding and willingness to adapt to state regulations and your continued partnership as we fight through the Covid-19 Pandemic. This has enabled us to keep the community and our residents as safe as possible while achieving excellent outcomes.

Parkvista continues to encourage safe visitations with your loved ones, however, with the recent public health order, I would like to provide you with a few updates regarding visitations which will go into effect as of January 7th 2022.

- All visitors (Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing) must enter through the main entrance of Parkvista which is located at 2525 N. Brea Blvd Fullerton, CA 92835 and check in with our receptionist. Memory Care visitors will enter through the Morningside kiosk located on 800 Morningside drive, Fullerton CA 92835.
- Visitors will be required to wear a surgical mask at all times during their visit (indoor and outdoor)
- *visitors must have all recommended doses (Fully vaccinated and with a booster) based on Table A below **and** provide evidence of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test within one day of visitation for antigen tests, and within two days of visitation for PCR tests;*
- *Visitors who are unable to provide vaccine information and/or do not have recommended doses will be permitted for outdoor visitation only. Visitors must provide evidence of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test within one day of visitation for antigen tests, and within two days of visitation for PCR tests.*

California Immunization Requirements for Indoor Visitation

World Health Organization (WHO) emergency use listing COVID-19 vaccine	All recommended doses	Booster dose 6 mos after getting all recommended doses	Single booster dose of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine
A mix and match series composed of any combination of FDA-approved, FDA-authorized, or WHO-EUL COVID-19 vaccines	All recommended doses	Booster dose 6 mos after getting all recommended doses	Single booster dose of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vac

- Please note, any guest or family member two years and older who is unvaccinated/unboosted will be required to completed a rapid test prior to entering the community per California Department of Public Health.
- Residents who are in a semi-private accommodation and are unable to leave their room may be approved for an in-door visitation with prior approval from DON (Sunday Porrastaton) or Administrator (Haidy Andrawes) in order to accommodate visit in a private location as roommate may not be present
- Visitors are not allowed in Communal Activities and Dining at this time due to space limitations- If you would like to share a meal with your loved one, family members are able to bring food to the community; however please make sure it is within your loves ones dietary guidelines. These shared meals will take place outdoors in order to maintain infection control and proper social distancing from others

Residents and guests planning an indoor visit should bring verification of their negative antigen or PCR results and show proof to the receptionist. Please note at home test kits must be completed upon arrival to Parkvista in order to verify testing accuracy. The executive order requires Parkvista to keep a log of visit and testing results. Due to the challenges with obtaining testing kits, Parkvista cannot guarantee we will have testing available when you come for your visit. Therefore, we ask that you make arrangement offsite for your testing and bring results with you or arrive to Park Vista with your at home test kit and perform the test upon arrival.

In the event that required documentation is not available, Parkvista will continue to offer alternative visits which include window and facetime calls. Please call our receptionist at 714-256-8111 to schedule a window visit or face time call.

Again, thank you for your continued partnership and flexibility as we weather this storm. I look forward to overcoming this season together as we have done over the past 20 months.
